CARROLL COUNTY PROPOSED PROJECTS INCLUDE:

- BHS - New classroom wing, band room addition, and other improvements
- CHS - Gym and dining room addition, and other improvements
- MZMS - New gym, bandroom, and other improvements
- SHES - Dining room addition and classroom replacement
- Temple Schools - New track and other facility improvements
- VRES - New classroom addition
- VRHS - Rebuild stadium and other improvements
- Technology, Fine Arts, and equipment funding for schools
- Other additions, renovations, and improvements districtwide



Since 2015, SPLOST dollars have provided funding for classroom additions, facility improvements, gymnasiums, athletic fields, technology and fine arts equipment.

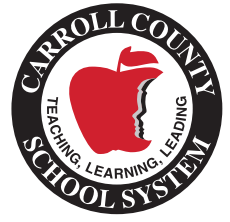

The final phase of the Carrollton High School replacement project, completed in time for the 2019 fall semester, provides an exceptional place of learning for all students. The new facility offers state-of-the-art career labs, versatile classroom spaces, a modern media center and large cafeteria, all designed with future growth in mind.
